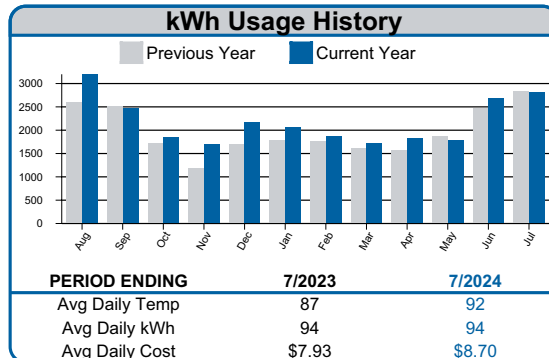

This is the per kWh charge. The more energy you use, the more this charge will be. We did have an increase to the Wholesale Peak Season Cost Adjustment in 2024.

STANDARD SALES TAXES

The state, county, and city all charge sales taxes on electric utility bills.

ST. GEORGE ENERGY TAX

The reason you pay this tax is that it is mandated by the St. George code to generate revenue for the city, which can be used to fund various public services and infrastructure projects. The tax is collected by Dixie Power and then remitted to the city as part of the regulatory framework established by the municipal government.
